1. Explain Universal declaration of Human Rights:
Ans: The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, (UDHR) is a milestone document in the history of human rights. Drafted by representatives with different legal and cultural backgrounds from all regions of the world, the Declaration was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly in Paris on 10 December 1948 (General Assembly resolution 217A) as a common standard of achievements for all peoples and all nations. It sets out, for the first time, fundamental human rights to be universally protected and it has been translated into over 500 languages. The UDHR is widely recognized as having inspired and paved the way for the adoption of more than seventy human rights treaties, applied today on a permanent basis at global and regional levels. All containing references to it in their preambles.

...recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of

Whereas disregard & contempt for human rights have resulted in barbarous acts which have outraged the conscience of mankind, and the advent of a world in which human beings shall enjoy freedom of speech and belief and freedom from fear and want has been proclaimed as the highest aspiration of the common people.

Whereas it is essential, if man is not to be compelled to have recourse, as a result, to rebellion against tyranny and oppression that human rights should be protected by the rule of law.

Whereas it is essential to promote the development of friendly relations between nations.

Whereas the peoples of the United Nations have in the Charter reaffirmed their faith in fundamental human rights, in the dignity and worth of the human person and in the equal rights of men and women and have determined to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom.

Whereas member states have pledged themselves to achieve, in co-operation with the United Nations, the promotion of universal respect for and observance of human rights and fundamental freedom

The General Assembly, proclaims this universal Declaration of human rights as a common standards of achievement for all peoples and all nations, to the end that every individual, & every organ of society, keeping this Declaration constantly in mind, shall strive by teaching and education to promote respect for these rights and freedoms and by progressive measures.

2. Explain N.H.R.C ?

Ans:- N.H.R.C stands for The National Human Rights Commission or NHRC is a standalone entity of the Government of India with mission of promoting & protecting human rights. It is a Statutory body mentioned in the Constitution of India. that was established in 1993 under the protection of Human rights Act. This act was further amended in 2006.

National Human Rights Commission, NHRCs

This article talks about an important non-constitutional body, the National Human Rights Commission.

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) established in 1993, is an important independent statutory body as per the provisions of the protection of Human rights Act of 1993 which was amended in 2006.

* Human rights are an indispensable part of society & human rights in India are watched by NHRC.

* NHRC acts as a watchdog of woman rights in the country.

* NHRC looks over the rights that are related to life, dignity, liberty & equality of the individual that is defined in section 2(1) of the PHR act.

* They are guaranteed by the constitution of India. embodied in the national or international covenants & are enforceable by the courts of India as well.

* NHRC was established in compliance with the Paris principles of H.R. 1991 which were adopted for the promotion & protection of human rights and were endorsed by the National United Nation at its General Assembly of 1993.

* The (NHRC) National Human Rights Commission is composed of chairperson & eight other members:

- * Those eight members are:
 - * Four full-time members.
 - * Four deemed members.

3. Explain challenges of human rights in India?

Ans: Human rights in India is an issue complicated by the country's large size & population as well as its diverse culture, despite its status as the world's largest. Sovereign, secular, democratic republic the constitution of India provides for fundamental rights, which includes freedom of religion, clauses also provide for freedom of speech, as well as separation of executive & Judiciary, and freedom of movement within the country and abroad. The country also has an independent Judiciary as well as bodies to look into issues of human rights. The 2016 report of human rights watch accepts the above mentioned facilities but goes on to state that India has serious human rights concerns. Civil society group face harassment and government critics face intimidation and lawsuits. therefore, these rights belong to them because of their existence. These rights are available to all people irrespective of their region, origin, race, religion, gender & nationality, because of this rights fundamental rights are so important they are sometimes called fundamental rights.

- Fundamental rights inherent rights, natural rights, and birthrights. Human rights are the rights and freedom to which every human being is entitled protection against breaches of these rights committed by a state (including the states of which the victim is a national) may in some cases based be enforced in international law. It is some times suggested that human rights (or some of them) are so fundamental that they form part of natural law. It is sometimes suggested that human rights (or some of them) are so fundamental that they form part of law but most of them are best regarded as forming part of the treaty. Thus, human rights are the rights of individual men and women to basic freedom. there are many such challenges national and international in front of human rights. The condition of women has improved but not as much as a thought. there are still many countries in which women haven't been denied rights. The condition of women is not good in countries, like Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iran, Syria, etc. similarly poverty could not be completely eradicated, people remain troubled in such a way that they are not able to survive and fight.

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- for their rights. Terrorism has also not ended completely in the world. It is very bad in Afghanistan rights now along with terrorism, and the condition of migrant refugees is pathetic which is being looked at.

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
