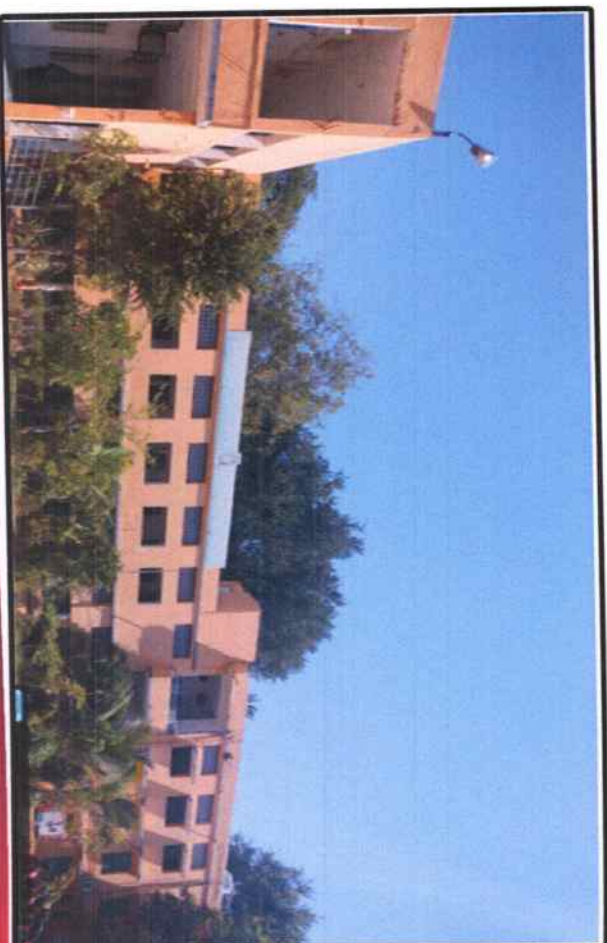

REPORT ON ADD ON COURSE - VOTING AWARENESS



1. Explain the importance of Election in Democracy. Gender and Politics in India

Ans Elections are of almost importance in any Democratic Country. As well all know, democracy is defined as a government of the People, for the People & by the people. Such governments, as in the ancient City States of Greece, can be formed with the people directly participating in them. But in Countries like India, China, the U.S.A, in the U.S.S.R. or in any modern State with the Several million People cannot have directly movement democracy. The nature of democracy is that Elected officials are accountable to the people, and they must return to the voters at Prescribed intervals to seek their mandate to continue Co. in office. for the reason most democratic Constitutions provide that Elections are held at fixed regular intervals

Women Only govern four of India's political Parties, from 1980 to 1970, 4.3% of Candidates and 70% of Electoral races had no women Candidates at all. As of 2013, it has been reported of the members of Parliament 11% were women in Lok Sabha and 10.6% in Rajya Sabha.

Women turnout during India's Parliamentary general Elections was 65.63% compared to 67.09% turnout for men. India ranks 20th from the bottom in terms of representation of women in Parliament.

Women have held the Posts of President and Prime Minister in India as well as Chief Ministers of various states Indian voters have elected Women to numerous State legislative assemblies and national Parliament for many decades.

Democracy is that form of governance where the elected representatives from the public make the government. Voting is the right that each adult individual has to elect the representative for the government. So voting for a representative to government. So voting for a representative to govern is the way the public participates in the governance of the States.

Electoral System ?

An Electoral System or voting System is a set of rules that determine how elections and referendums are conducted and how their results are determined. Electoral Systems are used in politics to elect governments, while non-political elections may take place in business non profit organisations and informal organisations.

These rules govern all aspects of voting process: When elections occur, who is allowed to vote, who can stand as a candidate, how ballots are marked and cast, how the ballots are counted, how votes translate into the election outcome, limits on campaign spending, and other factors that can affect the result.

Political electoral systems are defined by constitutions and electoral laws, are typically conducted by the election commissions, and can use multiple types of elections for different offices.

Some electoral systems elect a single winner to a unique position, such as prime minister, president or governor, while others elect multiple winners, such as members of parliament or boards of directors. When electing a legislature, areas may be divided into

constituencies with one or more representatives or the electorate may elect representatives or the as a single unit. voters may vote directly for an individual candidates or for a list of candidates put forward by a political party or alliance. There are many variations in electoral systems, the most common being party-list proportional representation - or first-past-the-post voting, plurality block voting, the two-round runoff system and ranked voting STV or instant-runoff web voting.

Mixed systems and some other electoral systems attempt to combine the benefits of non-proportional and proportional systems

The study of formally defined electoral methods is called social choice theory or voting theory, & this study can take place within the field of political science, economics or mathematics, and specifically with the subfields of game theory and mechanism design. impossibility proofs such as Arrow's impossibility theorem demonstrate that when voters have three or more alternatives, no preferential voting system can guarantee the race between two candidates remains unaffected when an irrelevant candidate participates or drops out of the election.

3 Explain the Challenges to Human rights in India.

Ans "Honour killing" is another challenge on human rights in India for which no effective legislation is in place so far to curb the heinous crime. From the economic point of view, employment of child labour & forced labour are the major challenges on human rights in India.

India, the world's largest democracy has a rich and diverse history, but it also faces significant challenges when it comes to the protection and promotion of human rights. The country's Constitution, adopted in 1950 provides a comprehensive framework for the protection of human rights, enshrined under Part III of the Constitution. However, the reality on the ground is often at odds with these lofty ideals. The present article aims to define what are human rights, their history & incorporation under the Indian Constitution & their status & the role played by the Supreme Court in protecting, preserving & upholding these rights.

Human rights are the basic rights & freedoms that belong to every person in the world, regardless of their nationality, race, religion, gender, or any other status. These rights include the right to life

liberty, and Security, freedom from Slavery and torture freedom of opinion & Expression, the right to work & Education, any many others. The Concept of human rights has evolved over time & is based on the idea that all individuals are entitled to certain fundamental rights simply by virtue of being human.

The modern Concept of human rights gained significant momentum after the atrocities of World War II leading to the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations in 1948.

The UDHR was the first international document to set out fundamental human rights to be universally protected, & it has since served as the foundation for numerous international human rights treaties & Conventions. The declaration consists of 30 articles that outline a wide range of Civil, political, economic, social, & cultural rights. It is to be noted that the adoption of the UDHR marked a significant milestone in the development of human rights as a global concern. In India, human rights are enshrined in the Part III of the Constitution itself & the judicial decisions.

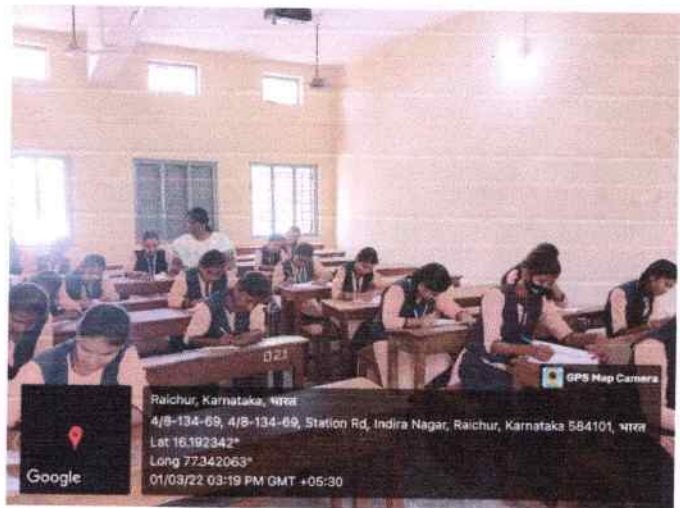
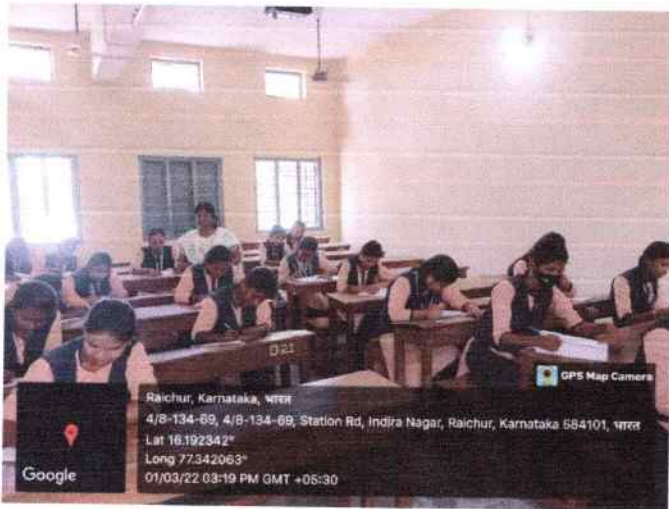
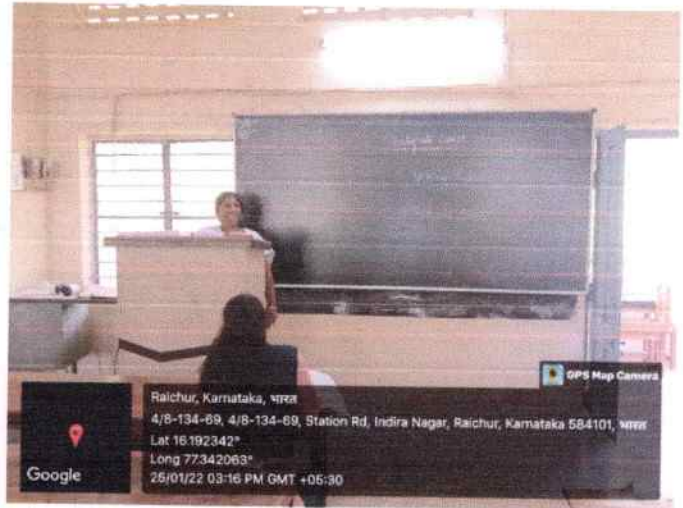
