

The IRCS is a voluntary humanitarian organization that aims to reduce and prevent human suffering and promote peace.

Here are some of the activities of the Karnataka State Branch of the IRCS:

- **Blood bank**: The IRCS has a 24/7 blood bank that collects blood from individuals, industries, educational institutions, and corporate offices. The blood bank uses a VITROS 3600 machine to test blood for HIV, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, Malaria, and Syphilis.
- **TB Control Project**: A project funded by USAID and UK aid.
- **Urban Family Welfare Centre**: A center that cares for mothers and children.
- Red Cross Opticals: An optical unit that sells low-cost optics.
- Youth Red Cross: A group movement for students in colleges.
